What is Porthole?

Porthole allows you to stream all the audio from your Mac to any amount of AirPlay speakers. All official Apple AirPlay devices are supported, as well as licensed AirPlay speakers and receivers and quite a few unofficial apps.

Porthole was created in Januari of 2012. Development of the first version took about 8 weeks.

What's New?

Version 1.7.0 (59), Released June 25th 2014

This latest release adds scripting support. You can now toggle speakers and get information on the available AirPlay devices through AppleScript.

Scripting paves the way for automating tasks and building external utilities that take advantage of Porthole's features.

Porthole for Mac Features

Listen to Music Through Several Receivers Simultaneously

Take advantage of every AirPlay output and play tunes around your home, in sync.

This feature was first introduced in iTunes, but still isn't available in Mac OS X or iOS. Porthole supports any amount of speakers.

Stream Your Favorite Music Player

Whether it's Spotify, Pandora, Rdio, SoundCloud, Grooveshark, Simfy, Last.fm, you name it.

Porthole streams all the audio that would normally play through the built-in speakers over AirPlay. This means every app is automatically supported.

AirPlay for Everyone

Porthole works on post 2007 Macs running Snow Leopard, Lion, Mountain Lion or Mavericks.

The only requirement is that the Mac runs Mac OS X 10.6.8+ (Snow Leopard) and has a 64-bit processor.

AirPlay + Your Mac's Speakers

While streaming, Porthole can optionally play through your Mac's output as well. All the wireless receivers and your Mac will even play in sync!

Syncing is supported by the AirPort Express, Apple TV, licensed speakers and receivers and a number of apps. The trial version allows you to test your setup.

Adjust the Volume per Speaker

You can use the volume keys on your keyboard to alter the main AirPlay volume. Even the mute button just works.

Think some of your speakers are a little too loud or too soft? Simply adjust their output by going into Preferences → Volume.

Setup Wireless Streaming in Seconds

The super simple wizard will take you through Porthole's features, connect to your speakers and make AirPlay as easy as it should be.

Save Clicks With the Speaker Panel

Want to start or stop streaming without taking your mind off what you're doing? Or toggle multiple speakers with the press of a button? Use Porthole's hotkey activated Speaker Panel to manage your setup, sans mouse.

Porthole is Scriptable

Use AppleScript (and JavaScript in Yosemite) to toggle speakers on or off and implement all kinds of cool tricks.

- Mac OS X 10.6.8 or later;
- AirPlay compatible speaker(s).

All features are available in the trial version and after purchasing a license it unlocks in place. These are the limitations:

- A computer voice chants "Danger Cove dot com" every few minutes;
- A nag screen that pops up every 10 minutes;
- There are strategically placed 'Buy Porthole'-buttons.

All minor updates (v1.x) are free for existing customers.

Porthole features an in-app purchase window. You can reach it by clicking the menu bar icon, then Buy a License Key...
